

## Vessels of Honor 2020 General Information

The goal of the conference is to see believers yield themselves as vessels available to God, sanctified and pure, prepared for the Master's use. The theme of the Vessels of Honor 2020 conference is **"So the church ... enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to increase" (Acts 9:31)**. The conference is for young adults, minimum age of 18, and is scheduled for Memorial Day weekend, May 22-25, 2020.

The conference begins with registration and a general session on Friday evening, May 22 at 7:30 pm. No dinner is served on Friday evening. The conference will conclude following the general session on Monday, May 25. No lunch is served on Monday noon.

### *SPEAKERS*

The conference will include general sessions and elective seminars for all attendees. **Keith Keyser, Steve Price and Jonathan Peck** will be speaking during the general sessions. These men will also be elective seminar speakers, along with **June Peck, Hannah Kelderman and Caleb Trent**. The ladies' ministry will be to the women.

In addition to the excellent opportunities for ministry there will also be plenty of time for fellowship during meals and between meetings. There will be group singing at the general sessions as well as opportunities for special music.

### *LOCATION*

The conference will be held on the campus of Park University in Parkville, Missouri, a Kansas City suburb located 15 minutes south of Kansas City International Airport. Park is a small private university located in a town of a few thousand people. The university setting provides attendees with sleeping quarters, dining, and meeting rooms all within walking distance. Recreational facilities are also available during free time.

### *LODGING*

Attendees will have the option of staying on campus or making their own housing arrangements. Married couples as well as singles are encouraged to attend. Typically, lodging is based on two people sharing one room with two adjoining rooms sharing a living area. If you desire to room with a particular roommate, you should indicate this preference when you register. There are private suites available for couples.

### *CHILDREN*

The conference does not provide arrangements for child care. Small children (under 2) are welcome to come along with their parents and can stay at no cost, however.
